2. What did Jesus mean by saying some would “not taste death until they see the Kingdom of God... with power” in Mark 9:1?
3. What happened to Jesus on the mountain?
4. Who appeared and what was Peter’s reaction? What was wrong with his reaction?
5. What did Jesus instruct the Peter, James, and John? What did they have trouble understanding?
6. What did Jesus mean by saying that Elijah had come?
7. Why was there a great crowd around the disciples in 9:14?
8. List observations (concentrate on the facts) from the healing of the boy with the unclean spirit in 9:14-29.

9. List personal applications (how does this apply to your life) from 9:14-29.

10. What were some of the things the disciples were having trouble understanding in Mark 9?

11. What were the disciples debating on their way to Capernaum and what can we learn from Jesus response?

12. What is the situation in verses 38-41 and what can you personally take from that?

13. Parallels to verses 42-50 are found where else in the Bible?

14. Explain Christ's great millstone teaching in verses 42?

15. How literally should we take verses 43-49 and what is the main teaching of the passage?

16. List some ways you have had to apply that teaching (from 43-49) to your life?

17. What is meant by the teaching on salt in 49-50?
