8. How has wealth impacted your spiritual life?

9. What did Christ promise the disciples in 10:28-31 and how can this encourage you?

10. What did Jesus say would happen to him in 10:32-34?

10. What did James and John request of Jesus in 10:35-45 and how did Jesus respond?

11. What is the key to true greatness in God's sight?
