4. What five global signs did Christ call birth pains? And, why is that term fitting?
5. What did Christ teach disciples should expect (during these times) on a personal level?
6. What important task must be completed before the end comes?
7. What did Jesus mean by saying, "But the one who endures to the end will be saved"?
8. What is meant by "the abomination of desolation standing where he ought not to be"?

9. When and how will Christ return? (Your answer should explain what's meant by "that tribulation".)

10. Who are the elect mentioned in verses 22 and 27?

11. What is the lesson of the fig tree in verses 28-31?

12. What is meant by "this generation will not pass away until all these things have taken place"?

13. How can the Son be God but not know the day or the hour of his return? Does God the Father keep things from God the Son? Explain.

14. What personal application is given in Mark 13:33-37?

15. List a key verse from Mark 13 and how it applies to your life.

16. Write two or more personal applications from Mark 13.
