2. What were the chief priests and scribes planning shortly before Passover? Why were they acting in secret?
3. Why did Jesus correct those who scolded the woman who anointed him with costly ointment?
4. What do you take from this account?
5. How might Judas' betrayal been related to events like the woman anointing Jesus?
6. How did the disciples acquire the room they used to celebrate the Passover? (Does this remind you of another time Jesus sent the disciples to do something?)
7. How does Christ's provision speak to your present situation?

8. What disturbing truth did Jesus share with the disciples during dinner?

9. What did Jesus say about the life of the one who would betray him? What do you think that means?

10. List observations from the first Lord's Supper described in verses 22-26.

11. How did the disciples respond to Jesus telling them they would all fall away?

12. What did Jesus say about Peter in particular?

13. How have you experienced God's grace through your failures?

14. List any personal applications or prayers motivated by verses 1-31.
